"Rotary is all about connection. When you join a club, you connect with the business leaders in your community. Rotary connects you and clubs and Districts for



service around the world. The whole basis of The Rotary Foundation is to connect Rotary clubs in one part of the world with Rotary clubs in another part of the world, typically Rotary clubs from a developed country with Rotary clubs in a developing country to undertake a humanitarian service project"

Unique projects :

RC Ranchi Midtown RID 3250 installed a Sanitary Pad vending machine at the barracks of women constables of the Jharkhand Armed Police

RC Hoshiapur North RID 3070 : In a novel project to create road safety awareness, Yamaraj intercepted motorists on the busy roads urging people to wear helmet and seat belt while driving and distributed roses to those drivers who observed the norms.





UNDERSTANDING GLOBAL GRANTS PROJECT



As Rotary club members, we contribute our skills, expertise and financial support to promote peace, fight disease, provide clean water, save mothers, support education and grow local economies. Rotary Global Grants support these efforts worldwide.

A Global Grant project must: Have a long term, sustainable impact. Include activities that fit into Rotary's area of focus. Invest at least \$30,000 within a community. Address an important need within the community. Strengthen the community's need to meet its own needs.

To make the project sustainable we have to: Start with the community's assessment of their needs. Encourage local ownership. Provide training. Buy local, as far as possible. Find local funding to integrate the project into the local community. Measure its success.

To qualify as a club for a Grant, one must attend a grant management seminar, complete the MOU between club and district and agree to any additional qualifications set by district. Collaboration is as much a part of Rotary as Service is. To apply for a Rotary grant through Rotary.org, two or more clubs must partner together: the host sponsor and the international sponsor. Both clubs must be qualified to participate, develop a plan, each must have a primary contact person, have project committees and partner with a cooperating organisation.

Requirements for a successful project plan are: Work as a team.

Plan for continuity. Decide who will do what Get expert advise, if required.

The Rotary Foundation accepts applications on global grants on a round the year basis. Details have to be submitted on project objectives, plan schedule, community needs, partners, budget and financing.

A very important aspect is to create a financial plan and manage grant funds responsibly. For this one has to: Develop a budget. Disburse grant funds properly during project implementation. Keep thorough financial records

Manage a club or district controlled separate bank account for the Global Grant Project Rotary asks for Grant reports to ensure good stewardship. Reports have to be submitted within 12 months of receiving the grant payment and every 12 months thereafter while the grant is open. For Global Grant Projects carried out in India, in case the project is not completed before 31 March, we have to submit a progress closure report with necessary documents before 30th May. The final closure report has to be submitted within two months after the project is complete.

RBNW is proud to have completed 4 memorable humanitarian Global Grant projects in partnership with overseas clubs. One of these is a reverse Global Grant Project where we are carrying out a project in the United States of America. In the next issues of this magazine some unique GG projects will be mentioned.
