Webinar on Eye Donation Awareness on 29th August 2020



Webinar on Eye Donation Awareness was organised on 29th August 2020 by Rotary district 3291 and OSWB to observe the national Eye donation fortnight .Rotary Club of Calcutta Inner City was the Host Club in this programme while Rotary Club of Joka was the Co- host club. National level speaker's participation for this event. PP Rtn. Dr. Vivek Datta *Chairman, Eye Care & Cornea Donation Committee RI Dist. 3291* moderated the session. Rtn. Rtsh Kapoor welcomed everyone on behalf of Rotary Club of Calcutta Inner city. Rtn. Sudip Mukherjee our Dist Governor for RI District 3291 opened the session. He spoke about the importance of this subject and accepted that the society is not aware of the importance of eye donation and this webinar is the need of the hour. Prof. Dr. G Mukherjee , President of Eye bank association of India was the Special Invitee for the webinar. In his presentation he introduced the subject and also spoke about the past glory in the corneal grafting surgery by the doctors. He told in India 6.8 million people suffer from vision problem. Every year we have 50000 new cases while the collection is about 2300 approx. cornea monthly. We have 200 Active eye banks in the country. He encouraged and thanked

Rotary for taking such opportunity and organising this webinar. The Covid Pandemic has disturbed the cycle of collection of eyes and such webinar would be an eye opener for the society. Prof. Dr. Narmata Sharma *General Secretary, All India Ophthalmological Society & EBAI was the Speaker National faculty. She spoke on the complete scenario of eye donation in our country. She told about the present day scenario, the fallout due to the Covid situation and the challenges in front of us. Eye donation is an act of donation one's eye after his/ her death. Only cornea blinds can be benefited through this. It is an act of charity, purely for the benefit of the society and is totally voluntary. Eyes from a dead person can enable Three blind people acquire vision. Dr. Tuhin Chowdhury, Cornea Consultant, Disha Eye Hospitals was the speaker host faculty and he spoke about the donor cornea procurement /collection formalities and transport of the cornea. He also told how the donor cornea are tested and utilised. He shared some of the challenging cases of patients. An Interactive session was moderated by Dr. Subhasish Nag. In total 138 participant participated in this webinar. Rtn. Noshir Framjee thanked everyone for joining the session and concluded the session.*
