The therapeutic use of music aims at reducing anxiety, improve cognitive functioning, promote physical rehabilitation enhance interpersonal and communication. It helps people in rediscovering themselves. Smt. Alokananda Roy, took up this as an experiment in this city few years back. Valmiki Pratibha, a well-known dance drama by Rabindranath Tagore tells the story of reformation – how the dreaded Dasyu Ratnakar metamorphosed into Valmiki, the sage, and went on to pen great epic, Ramayana. If Ratnakar can transform to Valmiki, then why not inmates of modern Correctional Homes can have a sense of purpose in their life? Smt. Roy's tireless persuasion, her acceptance and affection gave the convicts of the Prison, a sense of self-respect and dignity. The minds started changing and they started to identify themselves with the character of Valmiki getting transformed and believing in the possibility of new beginning. - A rare landmark that is referred by many as unparalleled in the history of prisons in the world. The Special Cover brought out by the West Bengal Postal Circle was in acknowledgement of this effort. Smt. Alokananda Roy, the eminent Dancer and Social-worker was the Guest of Honour and Smt.
