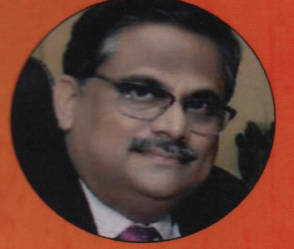

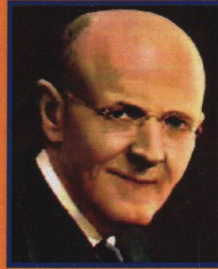

Education is the backbone of any country. Rotary's passion to see a totally literate India, a 'Shikshit Bharat' by 2025, Indian Rotarians have embraced a mission to ensure that no child is denied education.

Rotary India's MOLLI with HRD Ministry to make India literate is a big step. Through this, Rotary resolved to reach the students through radio and television to give quality education to the students more effectively.

Teachers form the backbone of education system. Teachers training is a big component of Rotary's literacy programme. To motivate them to be more involved in their work, outstanding teachers are being recognized by Rotary through awards.

Rotary in India through Rotary India Literacy Mission (RILM) and quality education through T-E-A-C-H i.e. T-Teacher support; E-e learning; A-Adult Literacy; C-Child Development; H-Happy school, tries to achieve total literacy and quality education. These programmes are inter-linked, resulting in improved learning outcome.

Asha Kiran programme through which children who have never been enrolled in school, dropped out or were irregular to school or have lagged behind are mainstreamed, regularized ensuring their retention in school after the required brushing up. This will help them access mainstream state funded schools. This year 60,000 children have been sent back to schools under Asha Kiran programme.

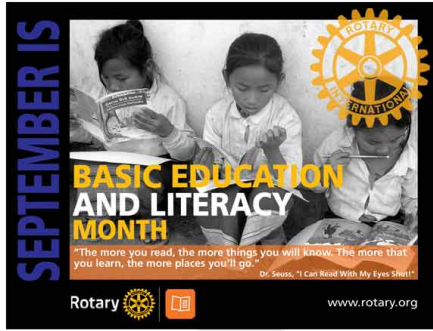
Rotary has a vast experience in e-learning. The pandemic has challenged the Rotary, the way children study and learn. Recognizing this in this month, i.e. September, RILM partnering with NCERT, will launch the biggest e-learning programme which will be beamed over 12 TV channels, benefiting over 15 crore children and enabling them to pursue their education from their homes. This e-learning is powered by RILM. Another component of literacy is Adult Literacy.

Rotary's goal is to strengthen the capacity of communities to support basic education and literacy, reduce gender disparity and increase adult literacy. If we want to empower the societies, reduce poverty, improved basic hygiene and health care and fight high infant and maternal mortality rates, we have to educate the girls. If you educate a man, you educate only an individual, but if you educate a woman, the entire family gets educated.

Let us create educated, enlightened, knowledgeable society.
